Entry 3 & Level 1 Essential Functional Skills in ICT*

These are excellent courses to develop your understanding and skills in IT. It will enhance your understanding of staying safe online whether you are working, shopping, searching for information or staying in touch with friends and family. This step by step course will give you the confidence and ability to develop your IT skills and gain a recognised qualification in a positive and supportive learning environment

Entry 3 & Level 1 Essential Digital Skills*

The skills acquired through this qualification help you to be digitally mobile and confident in accessing a range of platforms or digital searches, online purchases and transactions, and use technology in essential life situations. The aims of the course are to enable learners to:

- Develop essential digital skills necessary for work, life and further study
- Interact with digital devices and handle information appropriately
- Create, edit and store digital content
- Share content and communicate effectively using digital devices
- Develop transacting skills necessary for work and life
- Be safe, confident and responsible online

New Course - Entry 3 Award in Creative Digital Media - Social Media



Childcare

Our Childcare programme will equip you with the skills and experience you will need to undertake a career in the childcare sector. Our courses are relaxed and informal and you will be supported by skilled and experienced teaching staff throughout.

In addition to the course fee, there is an additional one-off charge of £30 which covers registration with CACHE, the examination awarding body.



L1 Certificate in Caring for Children

An introductory course starting in January for learners with little or no experience of childcare, who are thinking of a career in Primary, Secondary or a Special School setting. This L1 qualification is a good **introduction** to childcare and will give a good grounding for those wishing to undertake the L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools. Some of the topics covered include:

- Understanding Play for Early Learning
- Sharing Learning Experiences with Children
- Respecting and Valuing Children
- Supporting Healthy Choices
- Communicating with Children

This is an 22 week course and you will need to attend one 5 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

The L1 course fee of £120 is payable at enrolment or in 2 instalments of £60 per term, payable before the first day of each term.

New Course - Level 1 Award introduction to Early Years Settings

This is an fantastic course if you are interested in developing your knowledge and understanding of child development and exploring a possible career in the Early Years sector. Additionally, this course will provide you with an excellent starting point to progress onto other courses we offer around child development and teaching assistant qualification or indeed progress onto wider courses offer in the local area. Topics covered include:

- The value of play for babies and young children
- Management and organisation in an early years setting
- Roles and responsibilities in an early years setting



L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning

A full year course, starting in September, for learners with little or no experience of childcare, who would like to work in a Primary, Secondary or Special School setting. This recognised L2 qualification is the industry standard to work in a supervised role. This course is suitable for learners wanting to work as a Teaching Assistant, Learning Support Assistant or Special Educational Needs Assistant. Some of the topics covered include:

- Child Development
- Health & Safety / Safeguarding
- Supporting positive behaviour
- Supporting learning activities
- Communication Skills

Please Note: You will need to be working or on a practical placement for at least a total of one day per week for the duration of the course in a learning environment (school or college) as you'll need to show competence in both skills and knowledge.

This is **a full year course** and you will need to attend one 5 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

The L2 **course fee of £180** is payable at enrolment or in 3 instalments of £60 payable before the first day of each term.

Learners enrolling on the L2 course will be subject to an enhanced **Disclosure and Barring Service check**. The cost for this is currently £44.

Added Value:

Although not a qualification requirement, all childcare learners are offered the opportunity to gain a **L3 First Aid qualification** at a subsidised rate to enhance their employability skills.

Education & Training

Halton Adult Learning are pleased to offer 2 new Level 3 course in Education & Training which are ideal for anyone thinking of becoming a tutor or a trainer. We deliver two types of courses;

Level 3 Education & Training

This 20 week course is an introduction to teaching. It is ideal for anyone who is not currently teaching or training but who are already qualified in their intended teaching subject. It also provides an introductory teaching qualification for new teachers, trainers and assessors. This course is specifically for individuals intending to teach in FE Colleges, a Community Learning and Skills providers, independent training providers, local authorities and voluntary organisations.

Level 3 Pathways to Teaching

This course includes the Level 3 Education & Training course outlined above, but also includes the following additional qualifications:

- L1 Award in Safeguarding for Work, Education and Life
- Entry 3 Award in Equality and Diversity
- Entry 3 Award in British Values

There will also be an opportunity to have a work placement here in the Adult Learning team where you will be able to work alongside our dedicated tutor team in your chosen subject area.




